HUD DEFINITIONS

HUD funds five project types, the following housing project types are applicable to NY-518:

- **Transitional Housing (TH):** "...provides homeless individuals and families with the interim stability and support to successfully move to and maintain permanent housing. Transitional housing may be used to cover the costs of up to 24 months of housing with accompanying supportive services. Program participants must have a lease (or sublease) or occupancy agreement in place when residing in transitional housing."
- **Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH):** "...permanent housing with indefinite leasing or rental assistance paired with supportive services to assist homeless persons with a disability or families with an adult or child member with a disability achieve housing stability."

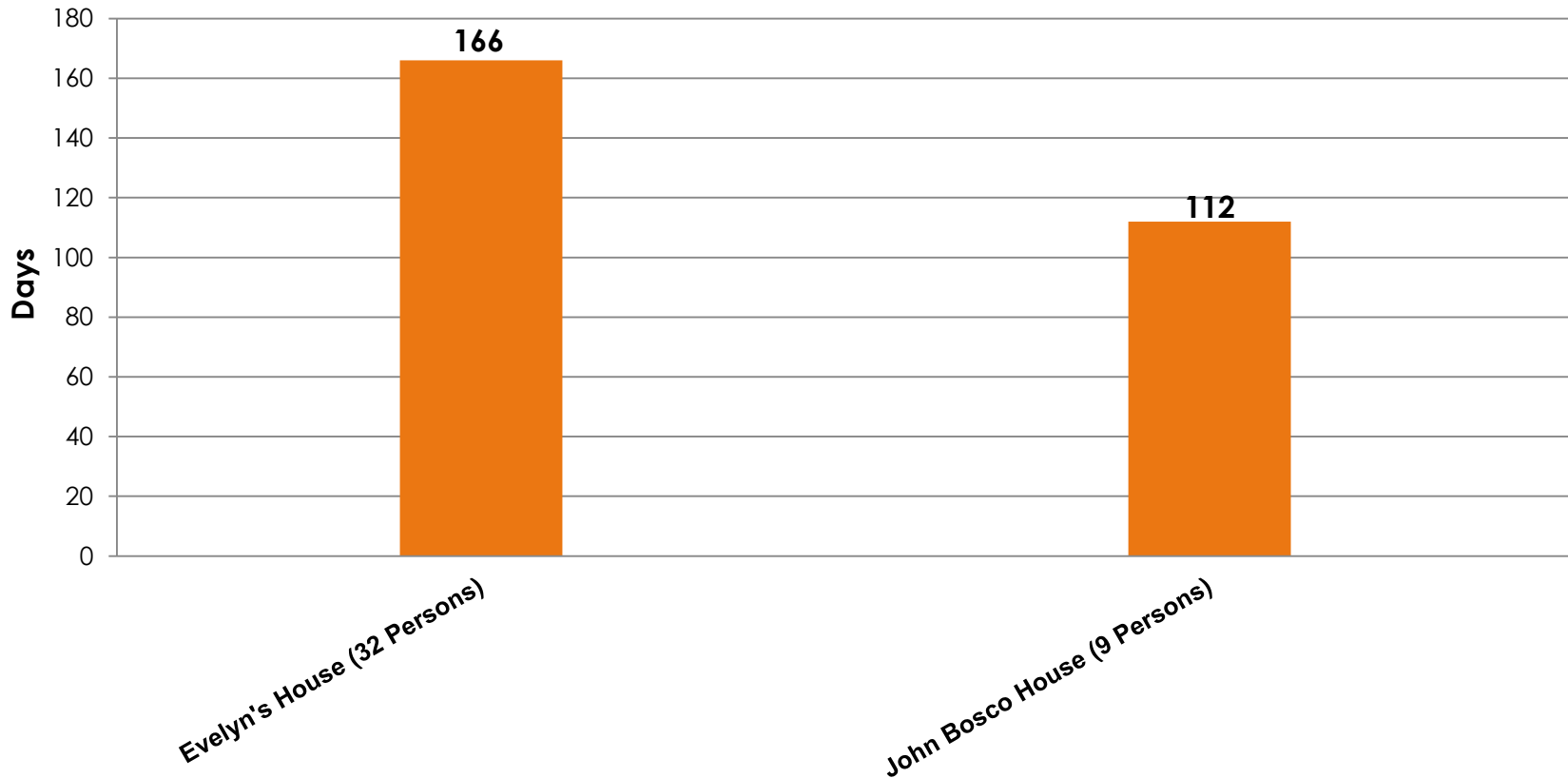

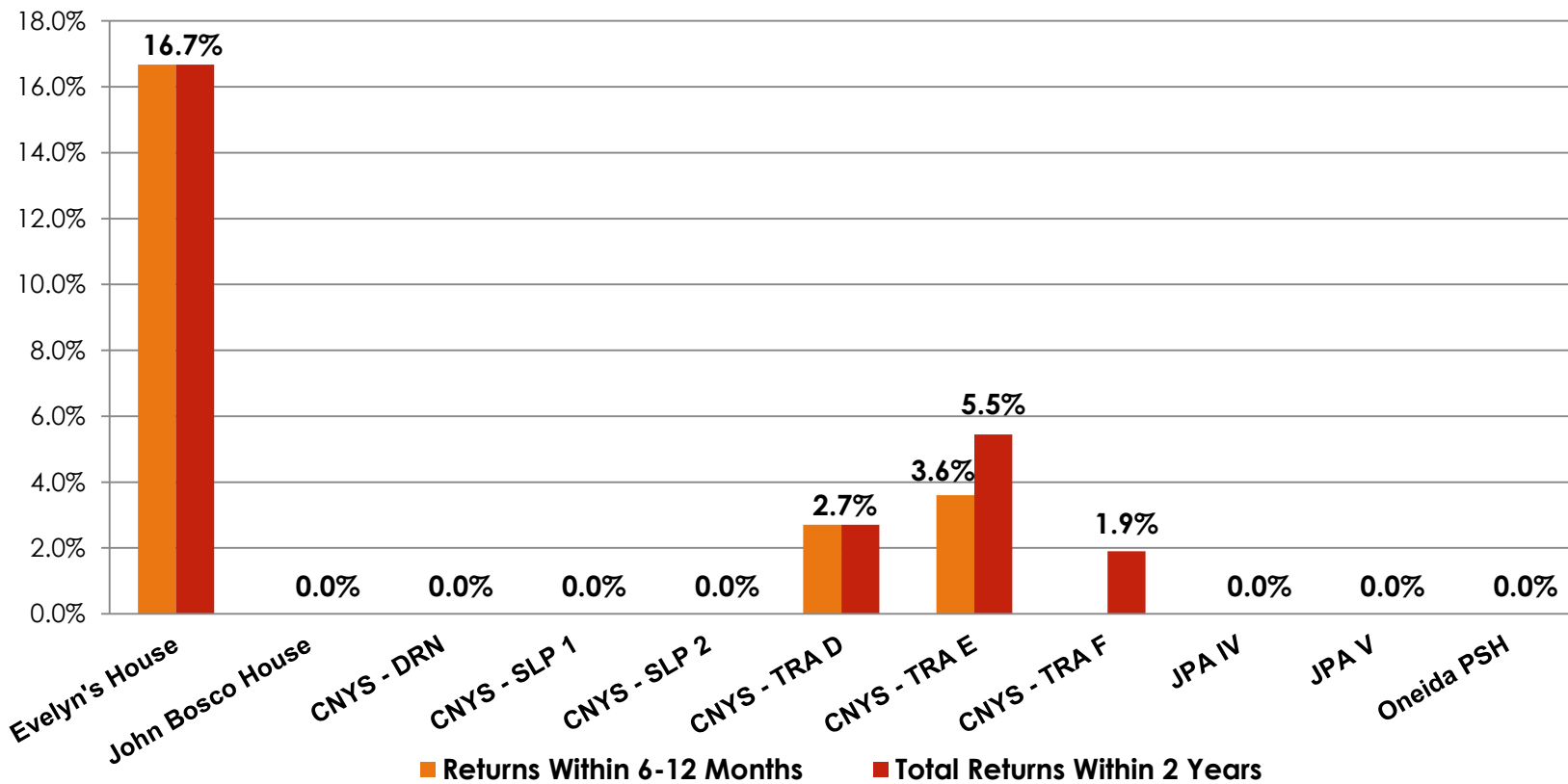
Measure 1: Length of Time Persons Remain Homeless

Average Length of Stay (TH Only)



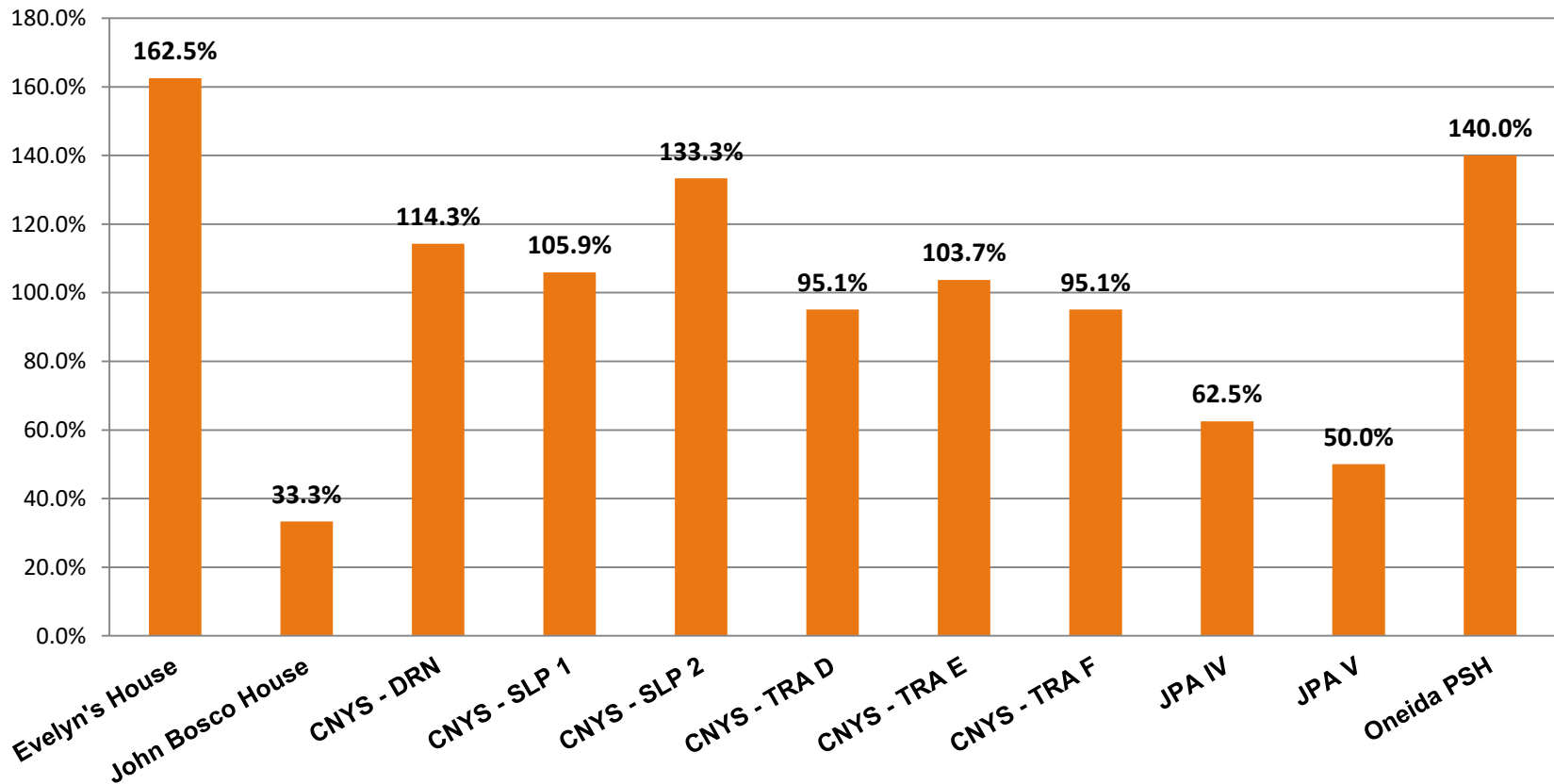
Measure 2: The Extent to which Persons who Exit Homelessness to Permanent Housing Destinations Return to Homelessness

Measure 3: Number of Homeless Persons

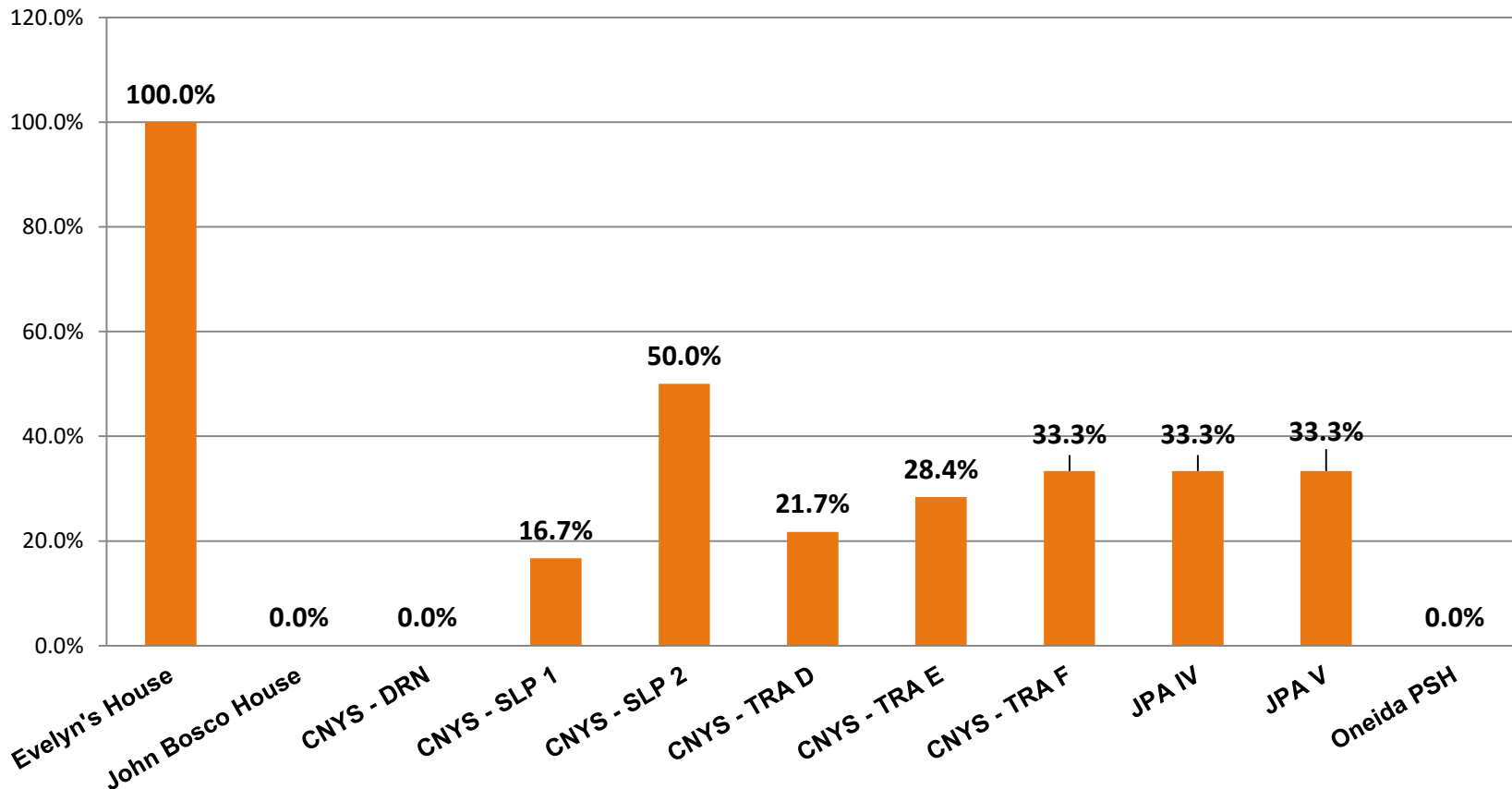
PIT Utilization Rate

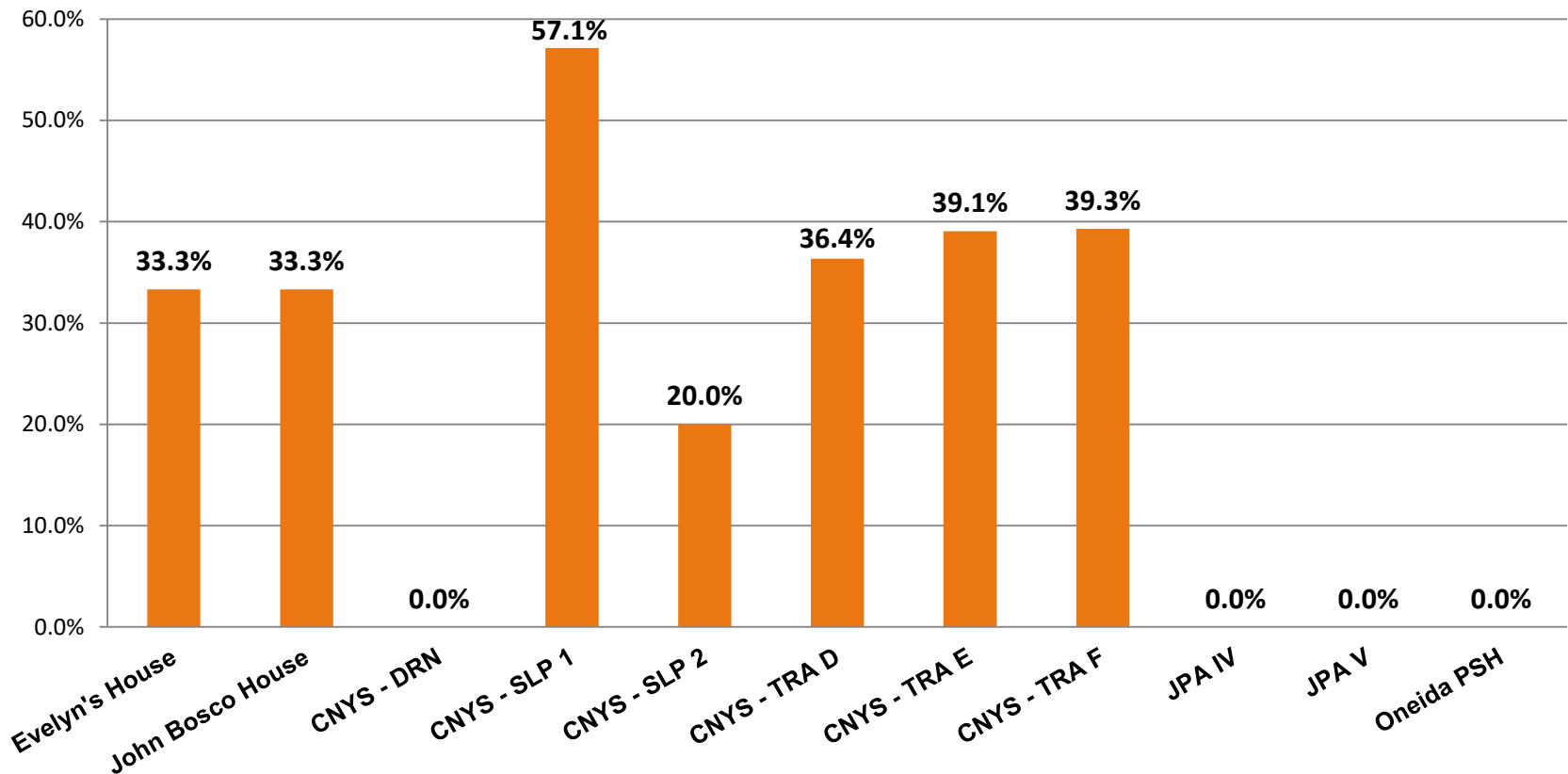
Adult Stayers with Change in Total Income

Adult Leavers with Change in Total Income

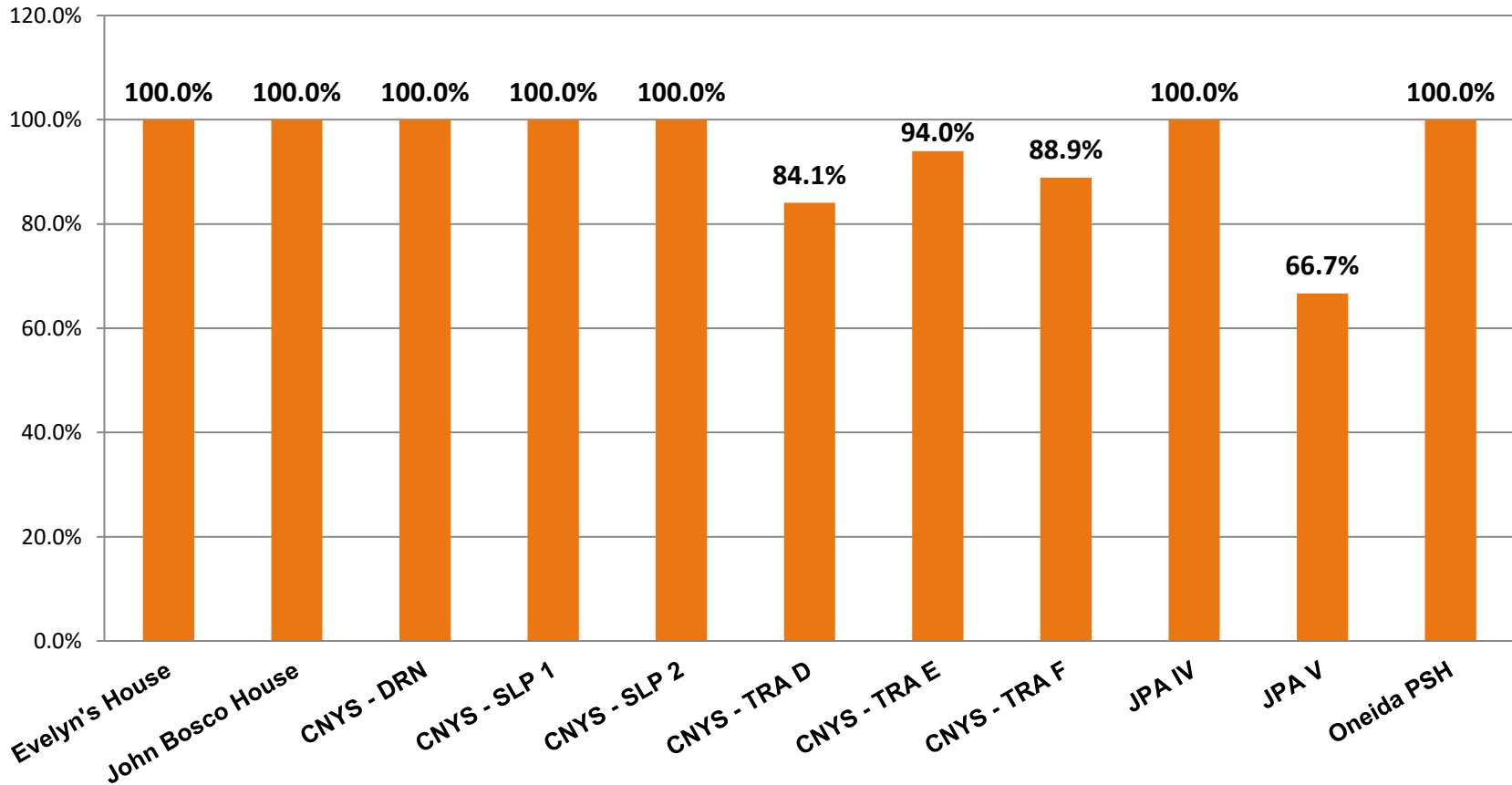

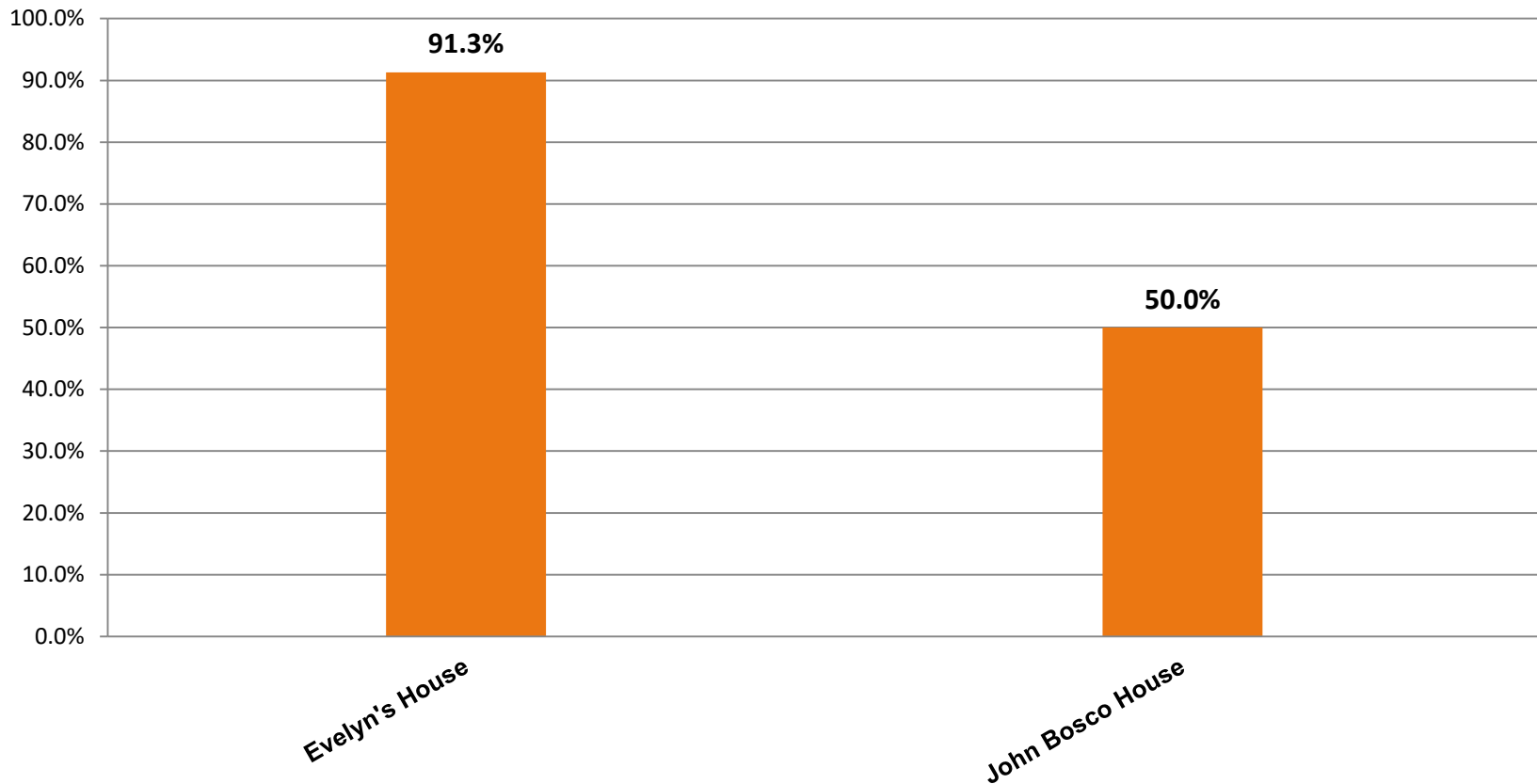
Measure 5: Number of Persons Who Become Homeless for the First Time

Measure 7: Successful Placement in or Retention of Permanent Housing

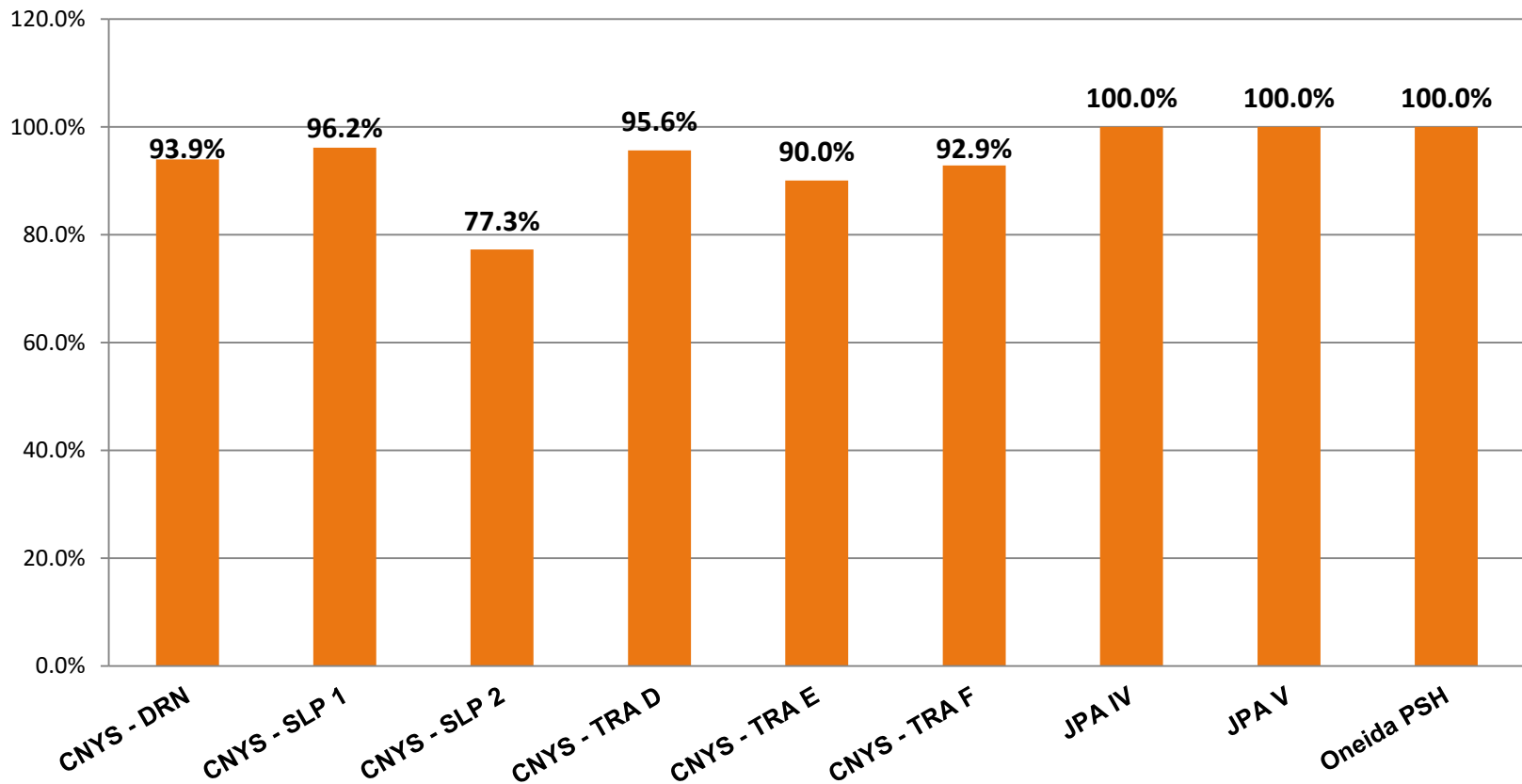
Exits to Permanent Housing (TH Only)
